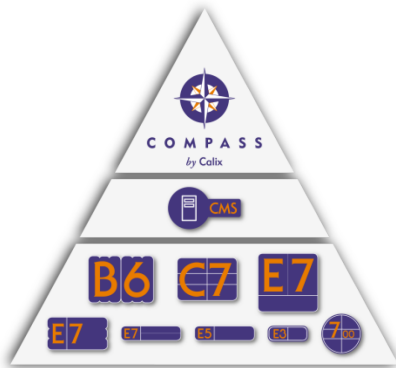


Network Performance Audit
